Superintendent's Report - Updates

Ms. Rianna made a statement regarding the Connolly school situation advising the public that prior to the opening of school the building ran out of oil therefore they switches the system to gas which caused a back draft into the school. Windows and doors were opened immediately. Around 9:45-10:00am some student and staff felt sick therefore the fire department and EMS were dispatched to the school. The fire department checked the air for carbon monoxide and the levels came back at a zero reading. EMS along with the school nurse checked students and staff, some students were released to parents. A connect ed was sent out to Connolly families and letters went home in the children's backpacks.
Three High School Student (Elijah Ambles, Brandon Aviles & Corey Dinkins) were presented with certificates for their acts of kindness. These boys have helped senior citizens and disabled individuals in various ways and for that they were commended.
High School Senior, Samantha DiPaola, presented to the board of education along with a few other students the assets of a nine period day. They gave examples of the benefits and mentioned a petition with 200 signatures thus far that agree with the needed extra period.
A presentation by Victoria Galante, Assistant Superintendent for Business, was made updating the board of education and the community with our upcoming budget. She answered questions as they arose.
