Report:

- **Mr. Tortorici** reported that Teacher Contract negotiations were presently being held with representatives of the Teachers Union and Mr. John Gross, school attorney.
- **Dr. Aronstein** reported that four senior students were involved in a senior prank at the High School. Three of the students were arrested and the fourth surrendered to the authorities. Their actions resulted in their suspension from school and the requirement that they spend time in community service. After much deliberation, High School principal, Mr. Schenker, with the concurrence of Dr. Aronstein, agreed to allow the students to participate in their up-coming graduation ceremonies under the following conditions:
 - The students must return to the High School next spring and describe to next year's senior class what they and their families have endured because of their prank.
 - They apologize to the community for damaging a public building.
 - They must make restitution to the High School Custodian.

The students came forward at the meeting, introduced themselves and apologized for their actions. They agreed to the conditions presented by Mr. Schenker and Dr. Aronstein.
